DANGER





- 1. AMPCO tools protect against mechanical sparks (impact and friction) but NOT static sparks which can ignite flammable vapors, liquids, dusts and residues.
- 2. AMPCO tools should be grounded if there is a concern for static spark.
- Keep non-sparking tools clean and free from impregnated particles and other contaminants.
- 4. AMPCO and other copper-based tools should not be used in direct contact with acetylene, ethylene oxide, azide salts and explosives such as amatol, DBX, and lead azide.
- 5. AMPCO tools do not protect against hazards from self-reactive chemicals.
